Set a good example

Please be timely whenever possible.

Storytimes are short and every minute is full of fun and learning opportunities.

Don't be afraid to take a break.

Some days children aren't in the right mood for storytime. If a child becomes disruptive, please feel free to take a break away from storytime with a walk, toys or something else they will enjoy.

Keep learning together!

The program doesn't end when we sing goodbye. During craft time, playtime, at home, or around town you can keep learning by asking questions about topics we discussed, repeating songs we sang, and more!
